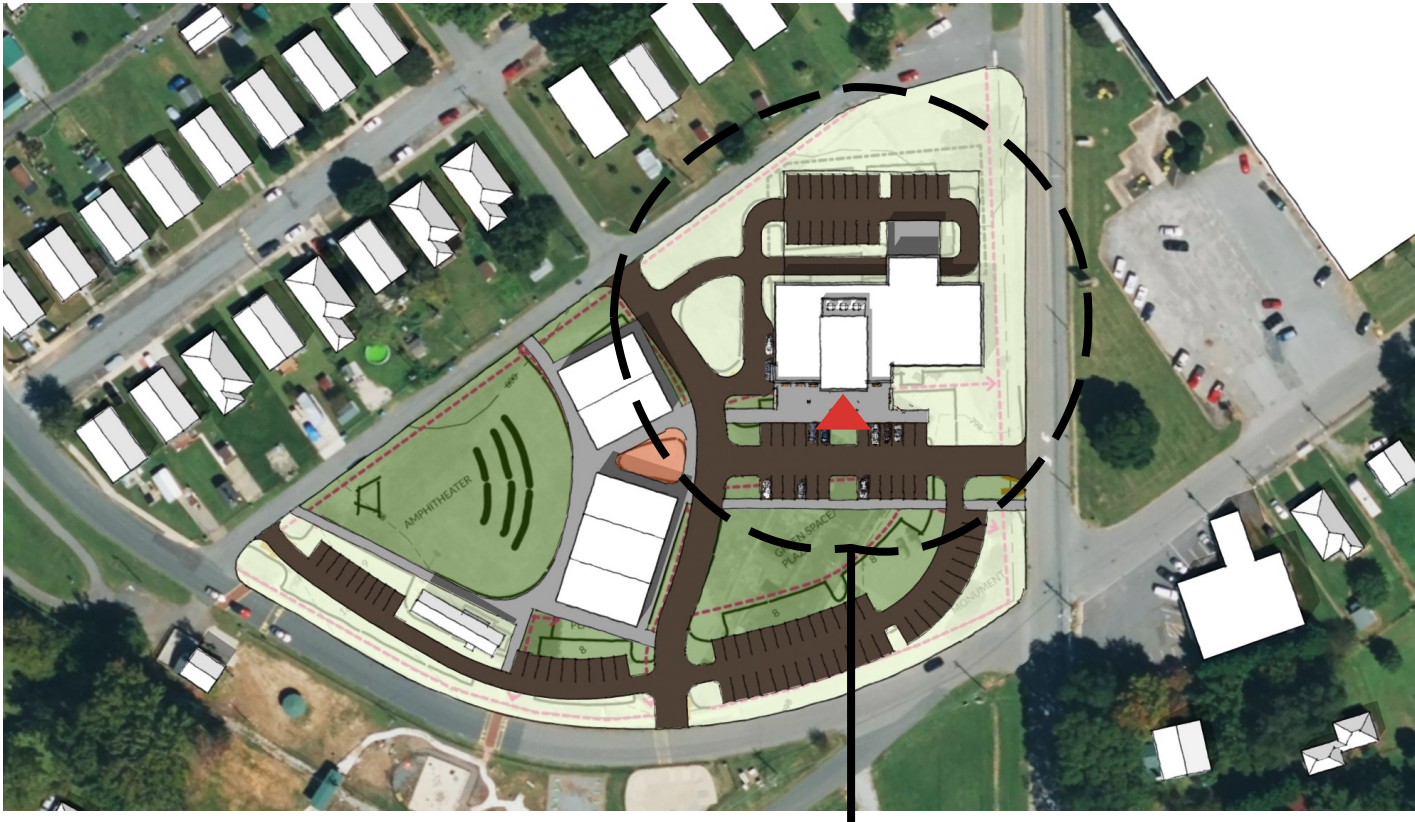

Town Hall & Police Station

Industrial | School Inspired:

- Focuses on incorporating building elements and materials inspired from the local industrial and school buildings.
- The exterior façade has a vertical rhythm of pilasters and contrast of materials seen locally.
- Entry has a civic presence expanded across the entry corridor towards the public way.
- Natural materials are both reflective on the exterior and interior tying the two together.
- Natural daylighting is optimized and shared between the main entry and the community room through clearstory windows.

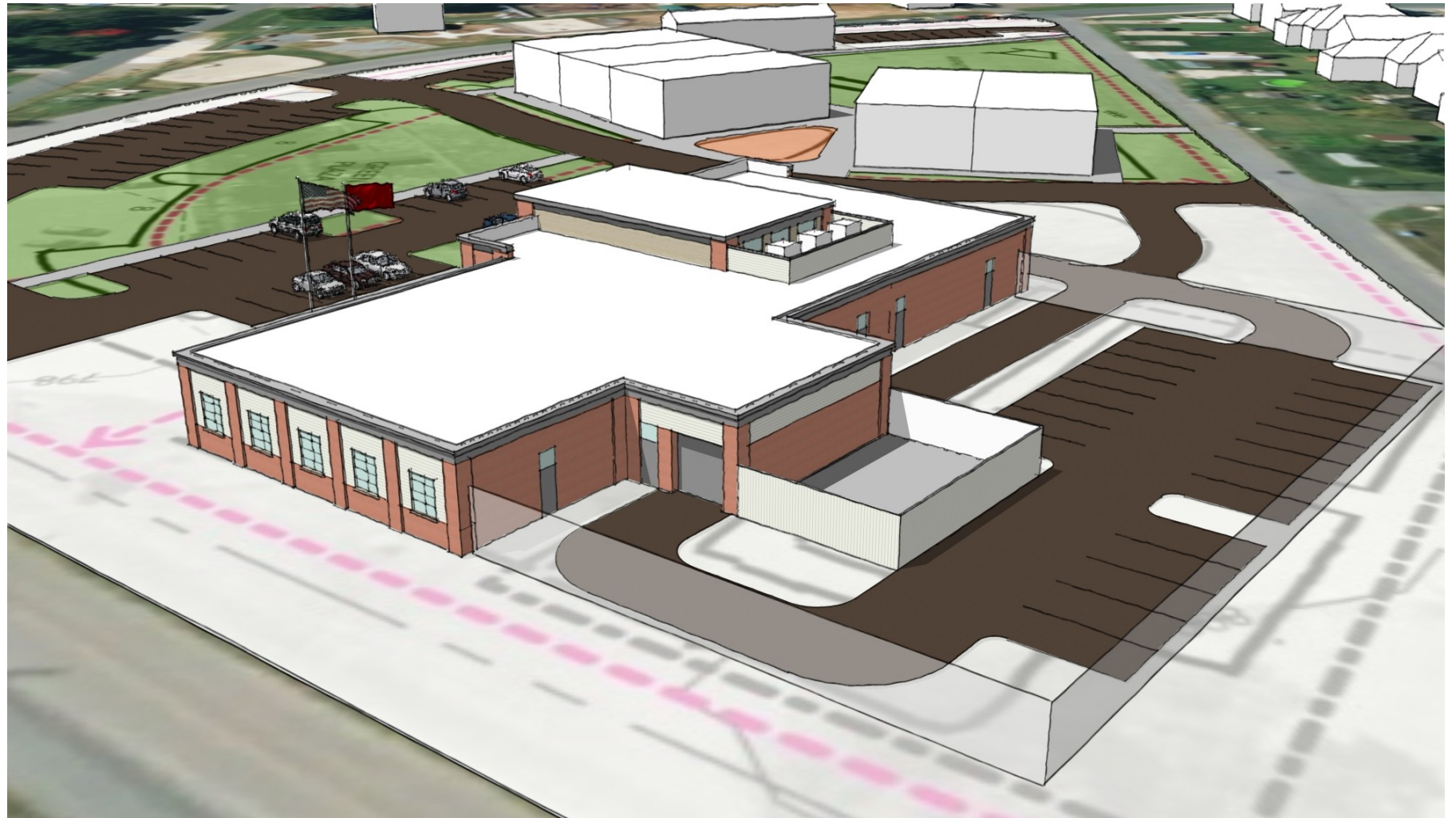

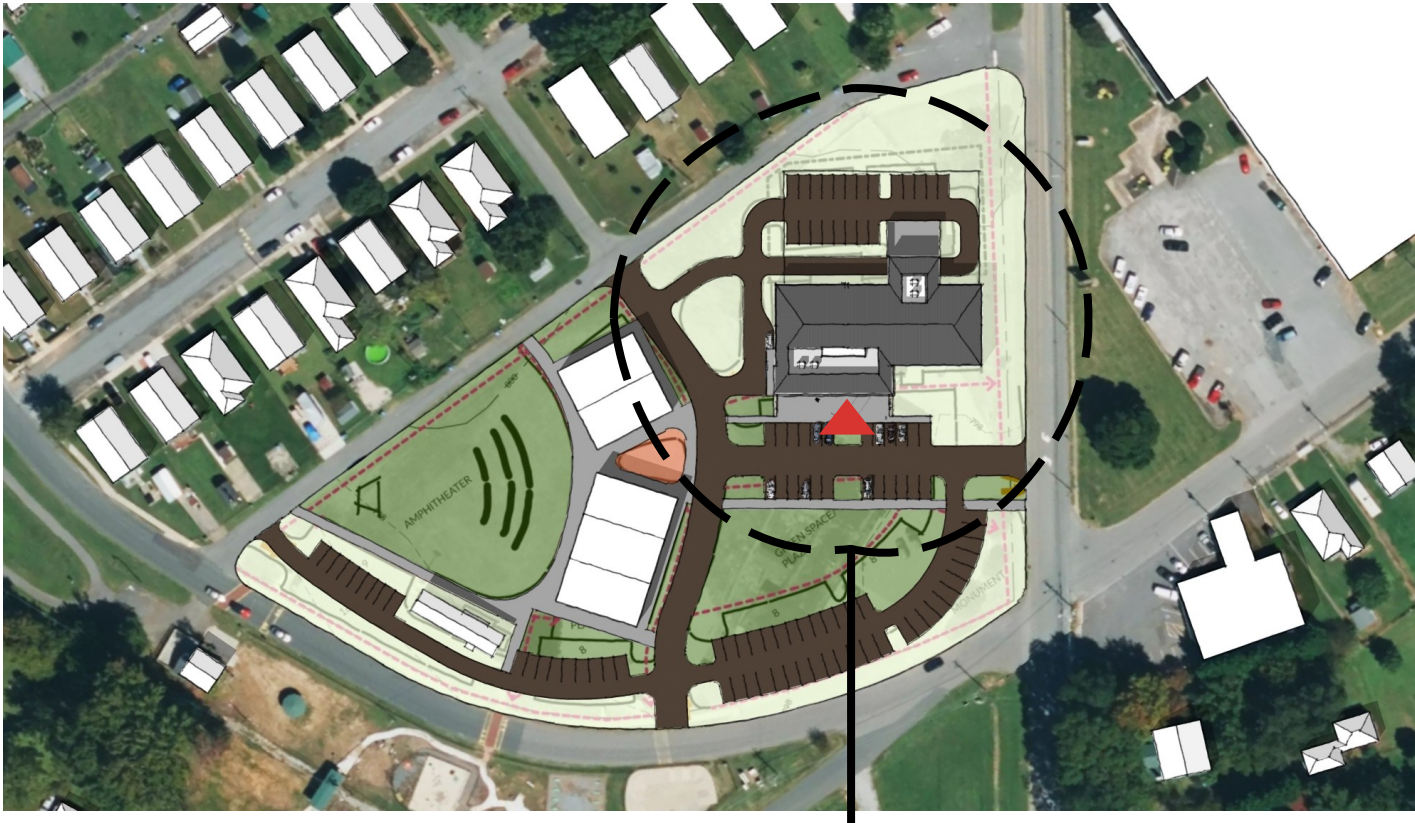

Site Plan

Town Hall & Police Station

Residential Inspired:

- Focuses on incorporating building elements and materials inspired from the local residences.
- Intended to blend in and have less of a civic presence.
- Incorporates a covered front porch connecting to the entry plaza.
- Main entry points directly relate to the covered porch access and do not face the public way.
- Natural materials are both reflective on the exterior and interior tying the two together.
- Natural daylighting is optimized and shared between the main entry and the community room through clearstory windows.

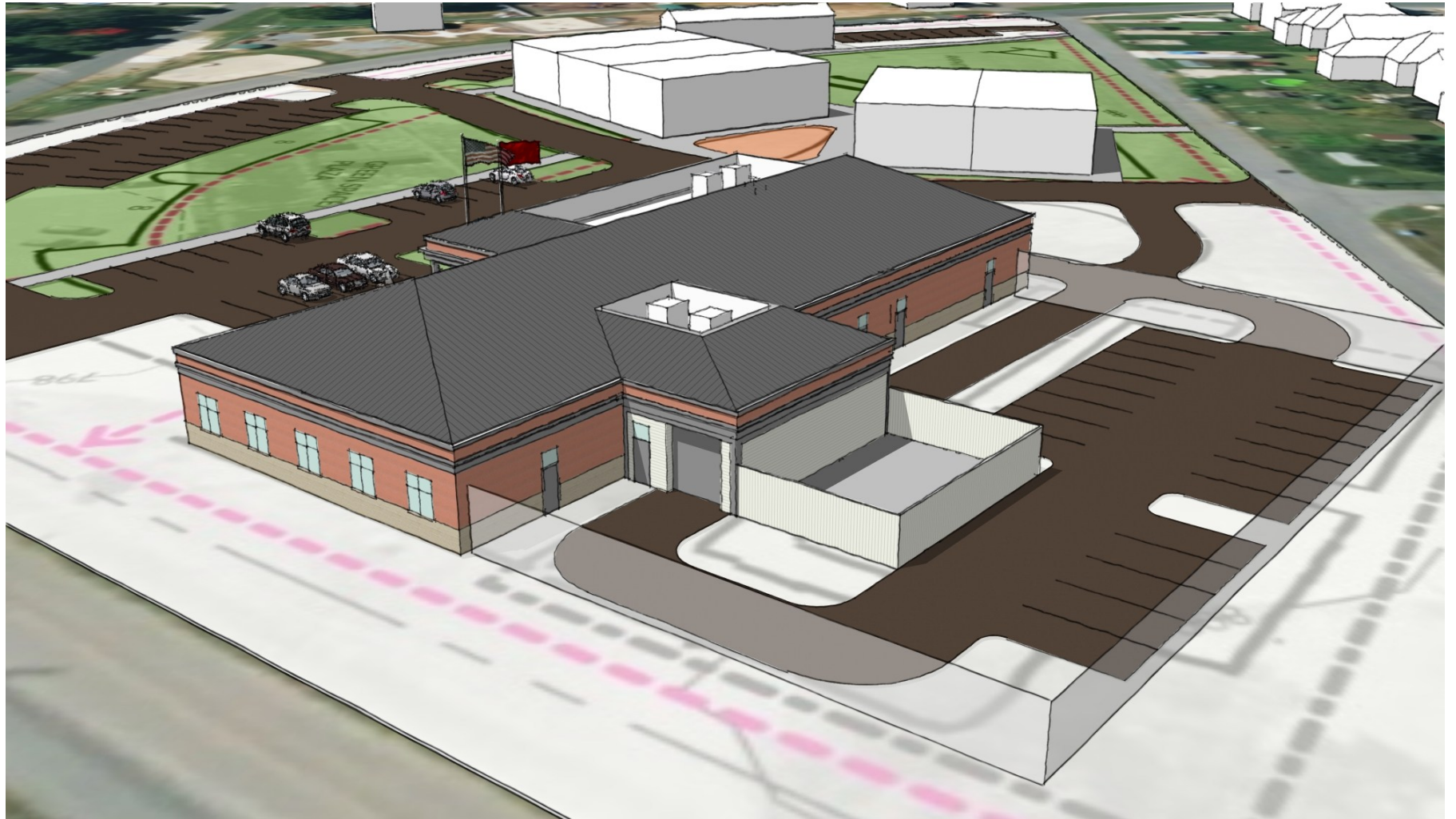

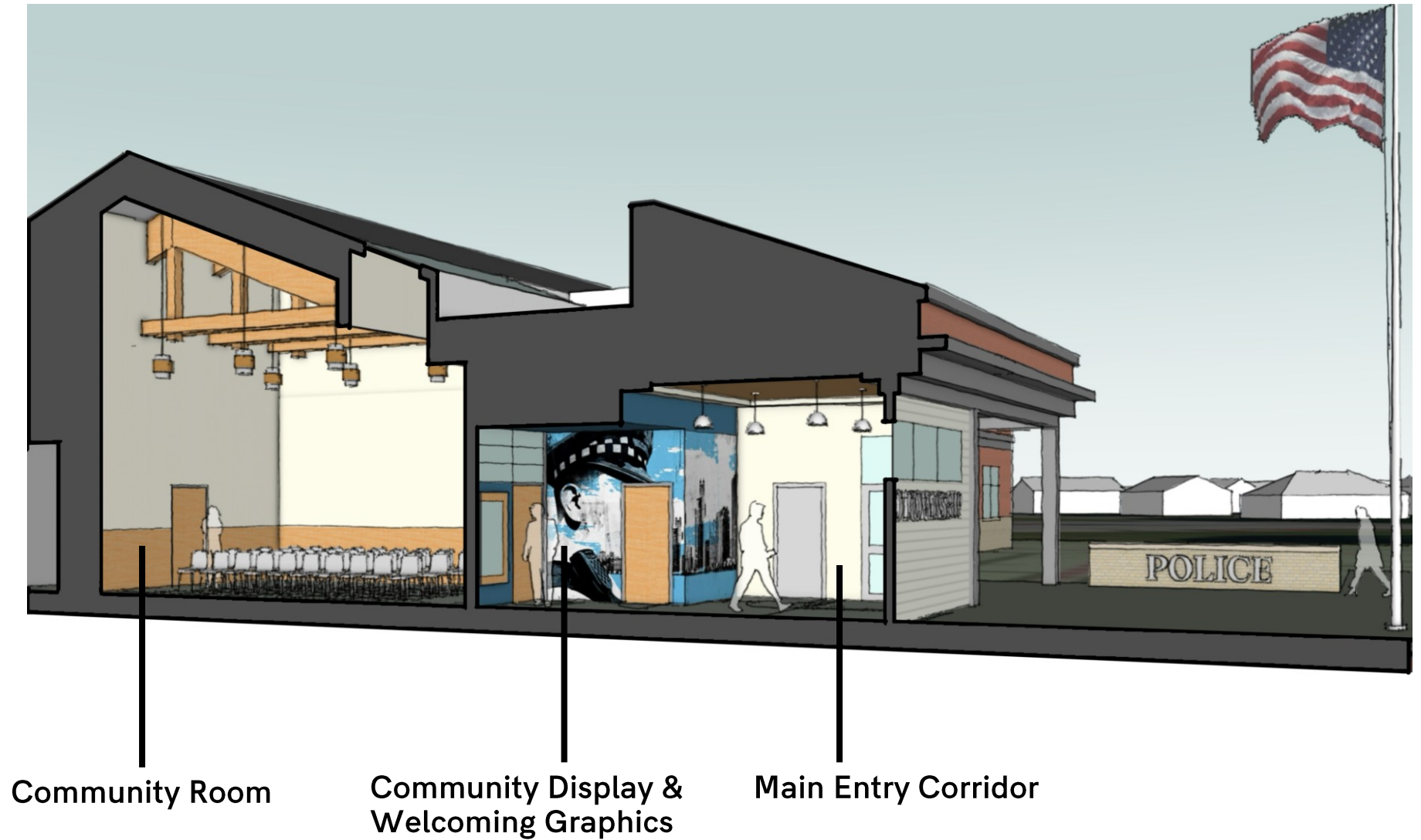

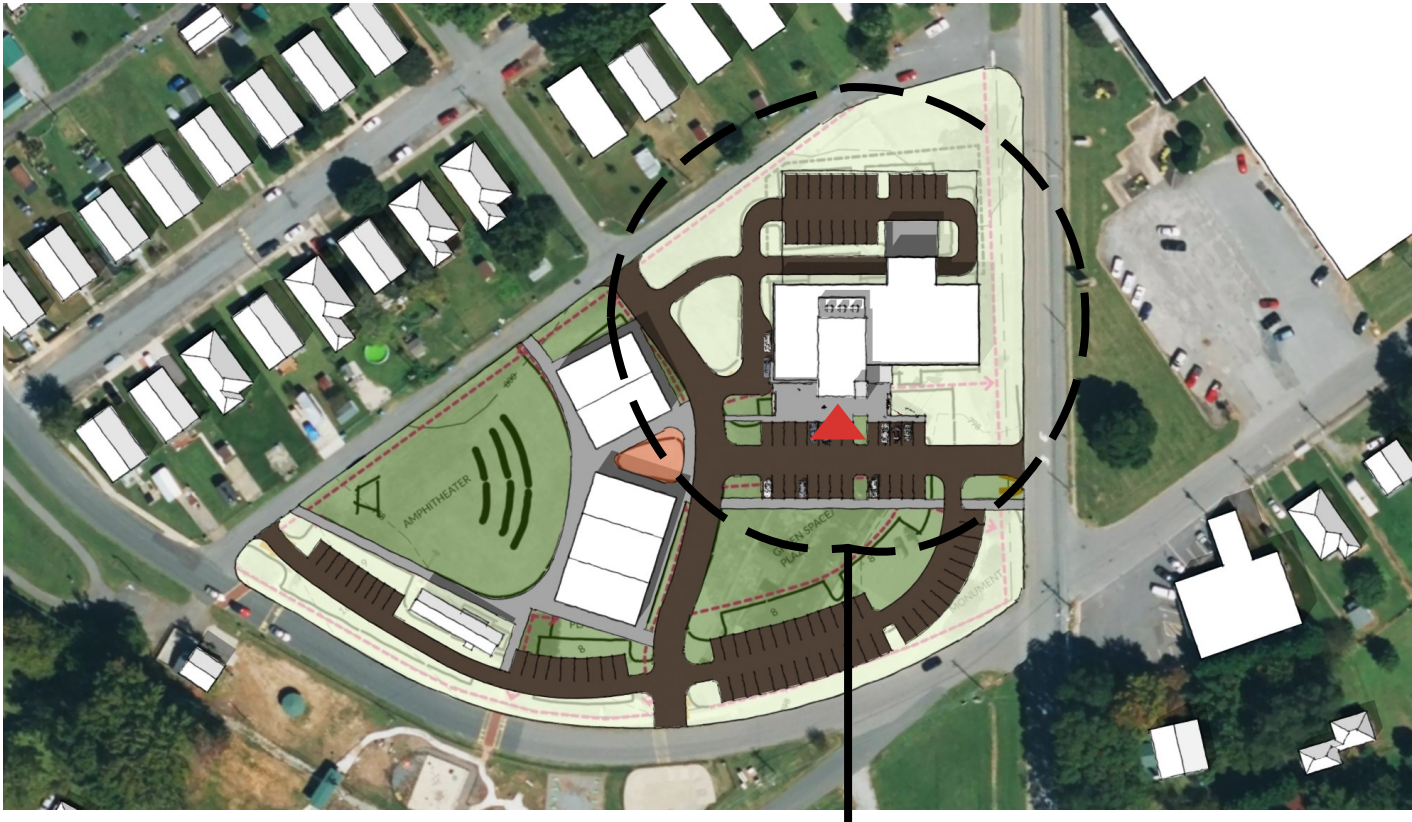

Site Plan

Town Hall & Police Station

Locally Inspired:

- Focuses on incorporating building elements inspired from the local water tower and mill.
- Uses both industrial and residential exterior materials to highlight the main entry and relate to the local architecture.
- Building forms create an identifiable marker using the tower element to signify a new town square or gathering space.
- Tower both acts as functional space to tell the towns story but also creates a destination for the community.
- Entry has a civic presence expanded across the entry corridor towards the public way.
- Natural materials are both reflective on the exterior and interior tying the two together.
- Natural daylighting is optimized and shared between the main entry and the community room through clearstory windows.

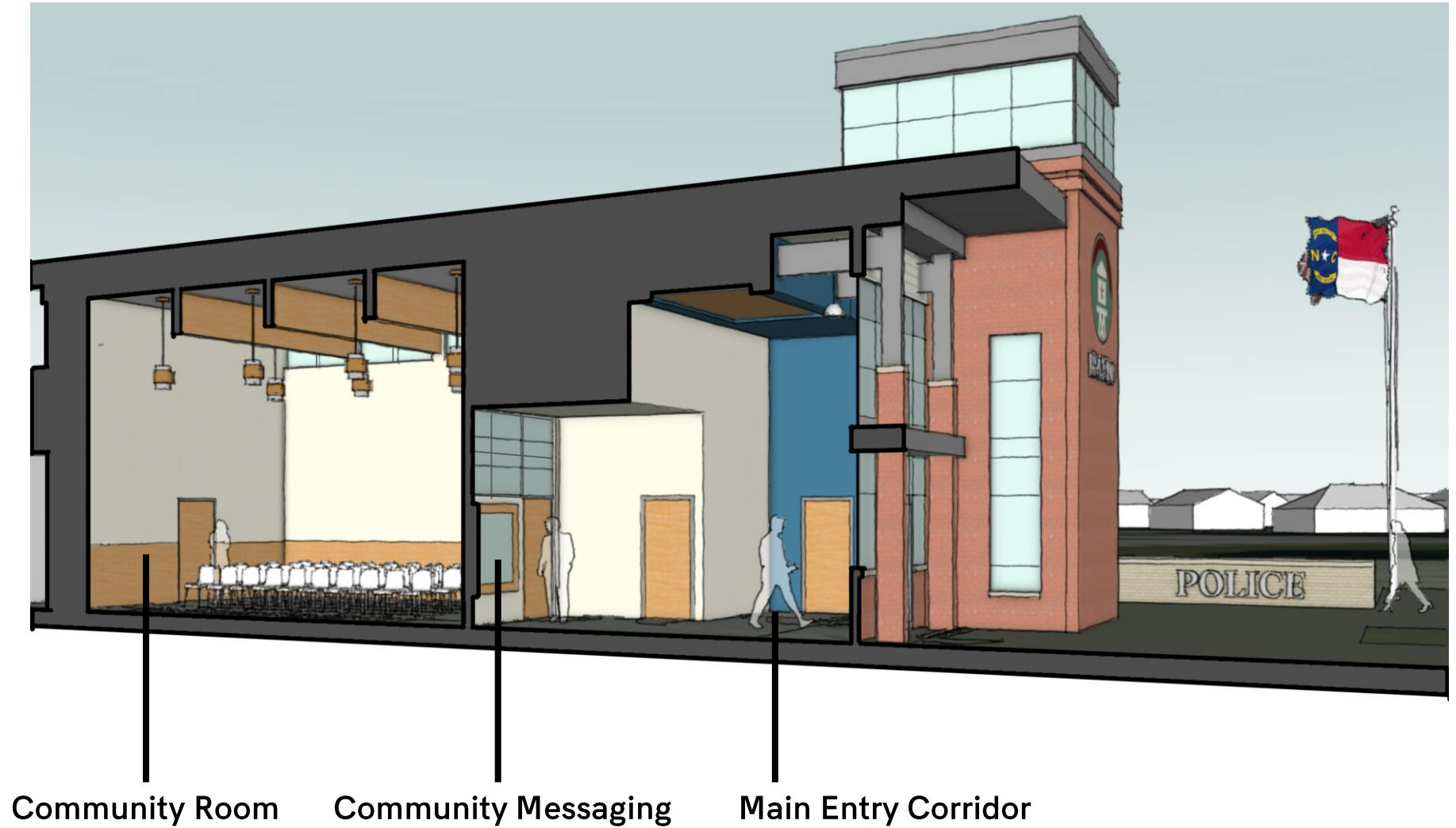
